With two homes in Nepal and Cambodia, hundreds of poor, abandoned children have been raised in our homes and are now loving parents with children and a decent job. The challenge is to be financially self sustaining as currently we don't have enough child sponsors especially in Cambodia. ● Why poverty remains?

In developing countries, jobs are hard to get and almost non-existent in remote villages. In Prey Veng, Cambodia, youths migrate to Phnom Penh to work while in Nepal, thousands find work overseas. We recently have a young family where the mother has passed away and the father cannot look after the children since he has to work in Phnom, Penh and have no relatives in Prey Veng to look after his children. To add to the misery, the father borrowed \$2,000 for medical treatment for his wife.





Stop students from dropping out of schools

Our Non Residential Child Sponsorships has helped hundreds of poor students and their families. Sponsored students no longer skip classes to earn money for the family.

If the teachers confirmed their attendance is good, the family gets a food pack of 50kg of rice, canned food and other supplies every two months. We have SOPs to ensure to ensure that the families received the correct amount of food,



The rice is weighed and the quality checked visually. In many food distribution programs, the rice is not weighed so the beneficiaries could be getting less than recorded. Poor quality and cheaper rice could be given but the NGO charged for better quality rice!
